Prayer Is Not the New Birth

God wants all men to pray to him. God hears and answers prayers. However, prayer is not the new birth. To pray is not to obey the gospel. In Acts 2:38, Peter did not tell the Jews to pray. He told them to repent and be baptized. The 'Sinner's Prayer' from Luke 18 - *"Lord, have mercy upon me a sinner"* - is inadequate to save. It is only a beginning - a recognition of need.

Paul was still lost at the end of his three days of prayer. (In Act 9:9, Paul was not eating or drinking for three days; I assume he was praying during this time.) he was not allowed to work for God until he washed away his sins. Ananias said to him; 'The God of our fathers has chosen you to know his will and to see the Right-eous One and to hear words from his mouth. You will be his witness to all men of what you have seen and heard. And now what are you waiting for? Get up, be baptized and wash your sins away calling on his name' (Acts 22:14-16).

Cornelius prayed yet still was lost. He was pleasing to God because he did good works and prayed to God. 'At Caesarea there was a man named Cornelius....He and all his family were devout and God-fearing: he gave generously to those in need and prayed to God regularly' (Acts 10:1-2) And because he was pleasing to God, God led him to salvation. 'Your prayers and gifts to the poor have come up as a memorial offering before God. Now send men to Joppa to bring back a man named Simon who is called Peter. However, Cornelius was not saved until he was baptized. 'So he (Peter) ordered that they be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ.' Charles Hodge


