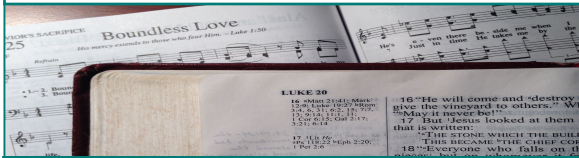

## LIVE FOR THE LIFE TO COME

“Precious in the sight of the LORD is the death of his saints.” Psalm 116:15

That’s an easy passage to quote, and, when not grieving, easy to believe. But when we lose someone special to us; someone we love; the task is “easier said than done.” That’s kinda where I am today, thinking about my friend Kathy. She’ll always be special to me and, though I’m pleased to know that she is “absent from the body” and “present with the LORD” I’m really going to miss her.

Most of you know her better than me, but I did get to know her well as we prepared to move up here and afterward, when we shared the office together. Though not much older than me – only seven years, I believe – Kathy, nonetheless, took a “maternal” interest in me and Kim. From the beginning, she looked out for us. She really wanted us to succeed, and I’m certain, in Paradise, she still wants us to succeed. I appreciate that.

There are other things I’d like to say in this space about her, but I think they’ll be better saved for her memorial, which will happen soon.

For now, I would like to remind us that this life in the flesh will soon come to an end. The bodies we walk around in will wear out, and they are wearing out. Even though I’m pleased to say I am having a measure of victory over my current health challenge, it doesn’t ultimately matter much, compared to the life to come. I might give myself a few more years of useful work in the flesh by making the changes I am making, but “. . . it is

appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment” (Hebrews 9:27). So, important as it is to treat the body God has given us well, the most important to think about is a question: How are you using your body for the Kingdom?

Who do you pray for?

Who do you help?

Who do you share your faith with?

Who do you depend on when you’re hurting?

Who do you worship?

Kathy, depending on God’s grace, did her best to answer all those questions as a disciple of Christ should. And now, she has gone on to receive a disciple’s reward. She understood, well, that this life in the flesh must end and made every effort to “lay up treasures in heaven.” I’m proud of her for that.

And I hope you are doing the same.

Beloved, let us make every effort to live for Christ and for the life to come, laying aside the “cares of the world”. All that earthly stuff, including our flesh, is passing away.
