

AUSCHWITZ

"Now there arose a new king over Egypt, who did not know Joseph." – Exodus 1:8

"Those who don't know history are doomed to repeat it." – Edmund Burke

79 years ago, last February, the Auschwitz Concentration Camp was liberated. On that day and in the days that followed, the world had to face what had long been an open secret in Germany and elsewhere; the cold, efficient, industrialized extermination of men, women and children because of their ethnicity and religion and other factors that rendered them, in the eyes of the Third Reich, "non-persons".

Now, years later, a question arises: Will the Holocaust be forgotten? Pharaoh "knew not Joseph" and persecuted God's people, in the process destroying his land, his soldiers and even his firstborn son. Revolutionary France cast God aside and the land embraced a terrifying insanity, the guillotine falling on good and evil alike. Many in America who forgot – or ignored – the humanity of the black man, subjecting our nation to large-scale bloodshed.

And in our own lifetime, forgetting God's moral laws has wrought chaos: financial, social, medical, political and spiritual. To forget the God we serve – and His rules – is to reap a whirlwind of negative consequences.

Considering all this, a few suggestions:

First, we must **Remember**. Remember our Sunday School Lessons. Remember our Creator. Remember our Redeemer. Remember the wages of sin and the free gift of God – eternal life in Christ (Romans 6:23).

He has done so much for us. We would be wise to please Him.

Second, we must **Believe** what we have been taught. "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life." "Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen." (Hebrews 11:1)

Second, we must learn to **Obey.** "Therefore whoever hears these sayings of Mine, and does them, I will liken him to a wise man who built his house on the rock . . ." (Matthew 7:24). "He who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues in it, and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does." (James 1:25). "If you love Me, you will keep my commandments." (John 14:15)

Finally, we must **Stand.** "Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand firm." (Ephesians 6:13) Perhaps we'll have to stand alone, but not *really* alone. Because the Shepherd will accompany us even ". . . through the valley of the shadow of death . . ." (Psalm 23:4)

For too many, the old stories in the Old Book are no longer relevant. So what? The world has forgotten before. Remember. Believe. Obey. And Stand – Strong. He will bless His servants and confirm His word.
