SURGERY & SMALL TALK

A few years ago, Daniel had to have surgery. He was nervous about it. So was I. So was Kimberly. Because, even though we knew the kind of surgery he was having wasn't terribly invasive or horrible, they were still going to cut him open! Horrible enough.

Arriving at the hospital at 6 a.m., I dropped Kim and Daniel off at the front entrance. After finding a parking place, I followed them inside. By 8 a.m. our boy was "under the knife" and we awaited word in the cafeteria.

We received it much sooner than we expected – at 8:30. Daniel had been in surgery for only a half-hour! Turns out, after opening him up, they discovered that there was nothing that needed fixing. Thank God!

After another half-hour; around 9 a.m. – we were allowed into the recovery room to see our son. He was groggy and goofy. He has always had "interesting" reactions to anesthesia. As he recovered, we visited more with the nurse than we did with Daniel. That nurse was so attentive, competent and kind. I thank God for people who are trained to heal and have a heart full of compassion.

As Daniel approached full consciousness and we were preparing to leave; Daniel was, in fact, in the wheelchair and we were waiting for the volunteer's arrival to wheel him out; I mentioned that I was a preacher. Then Daniel's nurse said something very interesting: "I notice your name is Campbell. You

wouldn't be part of that 'Stone-Campbell Movement' from way back, would you?"

"I am," I said. Following up, he said, "I used to be."

"Where do you go to church now?" I asked. He then
mentioned the name of an Episcopal church, the name
of which I have forgotten. And then it got really weird.
He told me that he graduated from a Christian College
in Arkansas! The same one from which most of my
whole family attended and graduated. I was talking to
a Harding boy. And not only a Harding boy, but a Chi
Sig, the same social club as Daniel's. You just never
know who you might meet once you leave the house!

Once again it was time to leave, so I gave him my business card and told him to call me anytime. I left the hospital elated and grateful to God. He never called back but I'd still like to discover what led to his departure.

You never know who you might meet when you're "out and about" and because of that reality, you should never forget that wherever you go, you go as an Ambassador for Christ. Learn to engage in friendly "small talk" as you pray for a door to open. And when it does, don't be afraid to admit you are a Christian. You never know where it might lead. If God can do all things, wouldn't that include helping us have conversations that might lead others to Him?
