RUN, TONY! RUN!

Every so often, I enjoy watching the old movie, "West Side Story". Recently, on Dale's visit, we watched replays of a few of the songs. He's a fan, too, and Kimberly, my "Broadway Baby", needs no encouragement to partake. We're partial to the original movie from back in the sixties, not the recently re-made version from a few years ago.

A few years ago, while watching the movie with Kim and Hannah before she left for college, something hit me that I hadn't thought about before. So as the final credits rolled and the policemen escorted Chino off to jail, I looked at my bride and said, "I hope Maria's next boyfriend doesn't listen to her very much." Because, well, let's face it! If Tony hadn't listened to Maria, Bernardo wouldn't have stabbed Riff. Which led to Tony killing Bernardo. And if Anita (Bernardo's girlfriend) hadn't listened to Maria, Tony would have stayed put in the Candy Store. And Chino wouldn't have found him and killed him!

All of the bloodshed. Because of Maria. All because of well-meaning, pure-in-heart, Maria. All because of pretty, petite, Maria. All because of not-so-bright Maria. She asked her friends to do really dumb, dangerous things. And they did them! Why did anybody listen to her?

I suppose with Tony it was obvious. He was in love. And as Samson teaches us in the Old Testament, "Love makes fools of us all . . ." But Anita couldn't see that Maria's poor judgment was not working out well? "Go ahead, Tony. Break up the fight. You can do it!" "Anita, I need you to deliver a message to Tony. He's hiding from the police over in the candy store. You

know, where the Jets, who hate you, hang out. Please? I love him!" Really?

The Bible warns of us that there are people we shouldn't heed. For example, The Adulterous Woman (Proverbs 7:6-27). Sinners, "greedy for gain", Who Entice (Proverbs 1:10-19). The Presumptuous Prophet (Deuteronomy 18:20-22). Maria was not like any of those people. So, why did disaster follow in her wake?

Perhaps this passage says it best:

"Whoever walks with the wise becomes wise, but the companion of fools will suffer harm."

(Proverbs 13:20). Foolishness, immaturity and letting our emotions "get the best of us"; or letting ourselves be influenced by such people; will take us down a difficult, perhaps deadly, path. Maria never had bad intentions. She never meant to cause harm to anyone. But she was young, inexperienced and unwise. And her foolish immaturity, mixed with the immaturity of those around her, led to disaster. Who "has your ear"? Who influences you? Who do you need to "keep at arm's length? Who should you talk to less; and pray for more?
