## **CAR TROUBLE**

I'm old enough to remember when car bumpers were merely ornamental. They didn't really do much. Then, promoted by the insurance companies and government regulation, the "5 MPH Bumper" became mandatory. Seemed, to many, to be a good idea at the time. I'm not so sure it has proven to be a good idea, because now and for the last fifty years, every car has been required to have lots of expensive, complicated gear tacked on the front and back of every automobile sold in America. It has cost a bundle for the consumer and I doubt any lives were saved.

I was reminded of this the other day, while backing into my driveway. I got too close to the rock retaining wall. Caught the "skin" of my bumper, wrenching it loose. Irritating. And to repair it was likely going to cost \$1,000.00 or more, my insurance deductible being too high. I also didn't want to file a claim because our rates were quite high enough already. I was resolved to escape the cost.

Went to the internet and found a plethora of videos and articles, showing how I could reattach the skin of my bumper. Was intrigued at the prospect. Had even zeroed in on the plan that seemed most "executable" by a man like me, unskilled. But I'd tried doing it before with another car and it hadn't worked very well.

Called my Insurance Company. Discovered what I had already suspected. I would likely not be paid much after meeting the deductible.

Finally decided to check in at a local Body Shop. I'd been getting to know them (2 accidents in six months. Don't ask). Maybe they had a solution.

Spoke to the Receptionist. She said one of their men would see me in a few minutes. He came out about five minutes later. Had already looked at the car. After we discussed the matter for a bit, and after he recognized me as a "repeat customer" (Don't ask. I mean it.), he said "I can't 'rig' it like you're asking me to and charge you for the work. Too much liability on me if I charge you. I'll do it for free." I enthusiastically agreed to his price.

About ten minutes later, my friend informed me the car had been repaired. Giving him my phone number, I told him if he needed anything at all, just call. I drove home a happy man.

It's good to know there are kindly people out there.
