FOR THE FAMILY

"Woman, how divine your mission Here upon our natal sod;
Keep – Oh, keep the young heart open,
Always to the breath of God!
All true trophies of the ages Are from mother-love impearled
For the hand that rocks the cradle Is the hand that rules the world."
- William Ross Wallace

Mr. Wallace's Nineteenth-Century poem speaks of an age many believe has passed away. An age in which parents raised their children "in the nurture and admonition of the Lord. (Ephesians 6:4)" An age in which mothers trained their children to love God and fathers trained their children to obey Him (and their parents!). An age many believe we have outgrown. Poems such as the foregoing and Bible verses like Ephesians 6:1-3 ("Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. 'Honor your father and mother,' which is the first commandment with promise: 'that it may be well with you and you may live long on the earth.") seem, to many, to be archaic; "old school"; obsolete.

Beloved, if we have outgrown "the old ways" described above, we have not blessed ourselves. Sowing to the wind of rebellion, we stand ready to reap the whirlwind of destruction (Hosea 8:7).

But destruction isn't necessarily our destiny; Jesus is alive! We can, with God's help, "step back from the brink"; rebuild Mom & Dad; rebuild our children; rebuild our faith. Take heart! – Christ has overcome

the world! (John 16:33)

Our families can be healed. Husbands and wives can live better together. Parents can bring up their children better. With God's favor, forgiveness and power, the next generation can "carry the torch" of faith rather than extinguishing it.

It's difficult to change, but not very difficult to recognize that change is necessary. Nor is it difficult to recognize that change must begin by crying out to our Lord in penitence, depending on Him for the help we need to change.

So . . . pray for your children today, committing them to their Father. Bless your children today, telling them about God's wondrous works. Listen to them intently and prayerfully. Teach them, asking God to open the doors of their hearts. Your children (and everyone else in your "circle") need to know that loving the Lord is important to you.

And if they're "grown and gone"? If they're still breathing, it's not over! Do the same over the telephone! Before ending your conversations with your children, pray for them, and let them hear you pray for them. Make sure they know where your allegiance lies. Make sure they know, despite what they may believe, that "as for (you) and (your) house, you will serve the Lord. (Joshua 24:15)".
