WRITER'S BLOCK

I've been struggling most of the day, trying to come up with a good Bulletin Article. And nothing comes to mind. I hate it when that happens!

It's happened before. For me, "Writer's Block" is a common occurrence, making its presence known too often. Its arrival used to scare me, but not anymore. Because when Writers Block shows up, I have opportunity to realize, once again, how dependent I am on the Almighty. I need His help – all the time!

And His help comes. Often just in time. I can't tell you how many times I have been completely "stuck" in preparation, only to remember that it was time to pray; to ask my Father for help.
