WORDS OF ENCOURAGEMENT

YELLOWSTONE & ARMAGEDDON

A few years ago, I discovered an alarming fact: if the Yellowstone Supervolcano erupts, we would be in big trouble. The destruction would be widespread and in some locations, long-lasting. Even outside the "blast zone" (potentially 240 cubic miles of deposits), crops would fail, temperatures would plummet, infrastructure would be clogged, death and destruction would proliferate.

As best as I can understand, this destruction is related to a massive introduction of volcanic ash into the atmosphere in the wake of such an eruption, a minimal result of which would be, at least, short-term destruction of our agricultural production. This, according to many who study such things, would precipitate global food shortages, riots, mass-starvation etc. etc.

What is a "supervolcano"? Generally, they are volcanos with the greatest potential, if they erupt, of inflicting the greatest destruction over the widest area; areas of destruction not seen in recent history. Not just at Yellowstone Park.

Okay – so here's the situation as I see it: supervolcanoes, when they erupt, create long-term disaster on a massive scale; and they're everywhere. Massive, destructive, world-altering heat monsters that could destroy our very of life in an instant. And they're all over the place, lurking right beneath the surface of the earth, rubbing their hands together like Snidely Whiplash, plotting our demise.

So, what do we do about this? What can we do? Do you know how to keep volcano from erupting? They tried in primitive times to appease the monsters by throwing human sacrifices down their gullets but that didn't work. More recently,

consideration has been given to drilling into, say, Yellowstone, to relieve the pressure. However, it has been more recently discovered that such drilling actually *increases* the possibility of an eruption. What, then, should we do?

I suggest we do what we have always done, especially when confronted by things that are completely out of our control: trust in God and obey Him. He created the earth. He created everything in it. He created the magma flows, fault lines, geysers, tectonic plates and everything else that makes up our planet. His creation is marvelous and, most importantly to this discussion, it is *His*. He created it all; he knows how to maintain it all.

Psalm 91 says, among other things, "A thousand may fall at your side; and ten thousand at your right hand. But it will not come near you." In other words, our Lord has this under control; He is able to protect us as we take shelter "under His wings". If He is capable of hanging this world on nothing out in the universe with the atmosphere, sun, moon, asteroids and planets perfectly placed to bless us, don'tcha think He knows about Yellowstone?
