#### WORDS OF ENCOURAGEMENT

## RESURRECTION

"Jesus said to her, 'Woman, why are you weeping? Whom are you seeking?'

She, supposing Him to be the gardener, said to Him, 'Sir, if You have carried Him away, tell me where You have laid Him, and I will take Him away.'

Jesus said to her, "Mary!"

She turned and said to Him, 'Rabboni!' (which is to say, Teacher)." – **John 20:15-16** 

"This Jesus God has raised up, of which we are all witnesses. Therefore being exalted to the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, He poured out this which you now see and hear . . . . Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ." — Acts 2:32-33,36

"If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men the most pitiable.

But now Christ is risen from the dead, and has become the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. For since by man came death, by Man also came the resurrection of the dead. For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive." – 1 Corinthians 15:19-22

Jesus changed everything. Had He not come, we would still be lost. Had He not lived a perfect life in the flesh, there would never have been a perfect sacrifice for our sins. Had He not been willing to die, we would still be signed over to eternal death. Had He not been raised on the Third Day, His Lordship would never have been confirmed.

But He did come. He did die. He was raised from the dead. He lives even now. And we have been living with the happy consequences of His Radical Love ever since. Before the Resurrection, Peter was mercurial. Brash one moment, fearful the next. And, while the Resurrection didn't change everything about Peter's personality (see Galatians 2), it's undeniable that the Peter who denied Christ three times and the Peter who preached on Pentecost were two very different men. Pentecost Peter, no matter what other faults he might have had, was filled with Christ-driven boldness. And when his hour of testing came, he died bearing witness to His Redeemer rather than denying the One he loved. Christ's Resurrection changed Peter. For good.

Not only was Peter changed; so were the rest of the apostles. Gone were the debates about being "greatest in the kingdom" – Christ was risen! Gone were their fears – Christ was risen! Where before, in their Master's hour of trial, they had scattered, they were now "all-in" for the Kingdom for the rest of their lives.

Because Christ is risen, we who serve Him have an optimistic hope that the world will never have. Other philosophies and religions don't compare. Materialism? In the end, as Solomon says, it is "vanity". Paganism? Based as it is on the worship of other gods, it is doomed to fail. Jihad? A powerful, devilish enemy, it is beyond cruel as a Master. And none of these "false prophets" will ever deliver as our Lord, Master and Savior did one Sunday Morning long ago, when He conquered the grave.

Christ is Risen! Listen to Him!
