#### WORDS OF ENCOURAGEMENT

## **ENGAGEMENT**

Kimberly and I were out of town most of last week, up in Littleton, NH. Pretty little town. And a town in which a church has been planted.

Wayne, an older gentleman with more than fifty years in ministry, decided to bring his wife to the "lower elevation" (lower, at least, than Colorado!) and plant a church up there. He's a strong man with a loving, persistent wife and I believe they will succeed.

During my life in ministry, I've served in New England (twice), Western Pennsylvania (once, and for a short time) and Virginia. Different locations with different people. But one constant remains: though the people are different with different preferences, cultures and attitudes, the people, still, are our business. Up in Littleton, things are kind of rural and "woke" at the same time. Strange combination, to me. Wayne and Weezy (his wife), born and raised Down South with many years in service Out West, have learned a lot about the people in Littleton and continue to learn every day. That's what must happen if one is to break through the noise and discover those who are searching for salvation. One must learn how to engage with the "locals" and draw them into our world if they are to find salvation in Him.

And we must do the same in our town, which is filled with many different "tribes, tounges, nations and people". But how? How, when most people like staying among "their own kind", do we reach across that "great gulf" and entice people to know us – and, more essential, to know Christ? How can our call to embrace Primitive Christianity and Unity penetrate when it likely appears that we're just one more offering on the Religious Smörgåsbord? A few suggestions:

- Be prayerful. "Except the Lord build the house, they labor in vain that build it." (Psalm 127:1)
- Be yourself. And be happy with who you are in Christ.

- **Be content** with who we are in Christ, even if there are things with which you are dissatisfied. Resist the temptation to remake the gathering in our image. Learn to trust the Spirit as He moves among the Brethren today, as we are, knowing that God works through us.
- **Be unafraid** to share Him and your friends in this congregation with your neighbors.

I am not suggesting any "method" or "program". This is not because I have anything against Methods or Programs.

But the genesis of outreach (engagement) is simpler than a method or program and more important. Without the "raw material" of searchers, does it matter if you have memorized your study method or designed a great program?

It all begins with engagement. And how does that begin? With three decisions: (1) Choose to pray that God would give you favor to lead a friend toward Christ; or spiritual conversation; or Bible Study; (2) Choose to be content with who you are, what your church represents and what you have to offer in Christ; and (3) Choose to open your mouth and give the friend you have been praying for opportunity to move your relationship from "surface" to "spiritual".

Your prayer, hospitality, enthusiasm, love, and courage; along with the Spirit of Christ and the truth of the Gospel; will cut through all the noise. And may we be given favor to see God give the increase.
