WORDS OF ENCOURAGEMENT

CHANGING TIMES

Trouble in Minneapolis. How will that end?
World-changing events in Davos. But how will the world change?

Storms brewing Down South and heading up our way. How will we be impacted? What about our children?

Seems like there's a lot going on lately. Not to mention the growth of Artificial Intelligence, an entire world in unpayable debt (What does a world do when the whole world owes more than it can pay?), families disintegrating, churches aging, "and on and on it goes." How do we handle it?

We don't. We trust in God – and in His word. "We have an anchor that keeps the soul." Especially when the storm is raging.

Malachi 3:6 — "For I the Lord do not change; therefore you, O children of Jacob, are not consumed." **Hebrews 13:8** — "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever." **James 1:17** — "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change."

He does not change. The wind may blow; the storm may rage; it may seem as though the Savior is "asleep in the stern" (**Matthew 8:23-27**) as our ship is tossed to and fro. Appearance aside, if we are "in the boat" with Him, we are safe and secure. **Isaiah 41:10** — "Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand." **Deuteronomy 31:8** — "It is the Lord who goes before you. He will be with you; he will not leave you or forsake you. Do not fear or be dismayed." **Proverbs 3:5-6** — "Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths."

Whatever troubles this world throws at us, He is with us in it. His help is with us. His

strength lifts us up. And He will "make our paths straight." We don't have to control things and events. He's at work and has been at work. We just need to "Trust and Obey", waiting to see what He has done and is doing.

Does the pace of change sometimes "freak you out" and trigger worries? Consider this: **Philippians 4:6-7** — "Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." **1 Peter 5:7** — "Cast all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you." **Psalms 46:1-2** — "God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear though the earth gives way..."

Bring those worries to God through prayer (and thanksgiving!) He will give you peace. He will give you help. "He cares for you."

Do you sometimes feel as though "all is lost"? Hang on! Endurance is key.

Matthew 24:13 — "But the one who endures to the end will be saved." **James 1:12** — "Blessed is the man who remains steadfast under trial, for when he has stood the test he will receive the crown of life, which God has promised to those who love him." **Galatians 6:9** — "And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up."

When our faith is tested through trials (**James 1:2-3**), don't give up. There will be a reward in this life – and especially in the next!

God steadied His people through exiles, storms, and empires. He is with you now, strengthening your walk and your walk with others. "Cast your cares upon Him."
