WORDS OF ENCOURAGEMENT

OUT OF EGYPT

“You shall speak all that I command you. And Aaron your brother shall tell Pharaoh to send the children of Israel out of his land. And I will harden Pharaoh’s heart, and multiply My signs and My wonders in the land of Egypt. But Pharaoh will not heed you, so that I may lay My hand on Egypt and bring My armies and My people, the children of Israel, out of the land of Egypt by great judgments. And the Egyptians shall know that I am the LORD, when I stretch out My hand on Egypt and bring out the children of Israel from among them.” – Exodus 7:2-5

Moses’s task was difficult. He was told to go to Pharaoh and ask him to let the Israelites go. And he was told to do this knowing that Pharaoh would not be willing to do so (“And I will harden Pharaoh’s heart...”). But God had plans for Israel; for Egypt; for Moses; for Pharaoh, so that’s how it had to be. The Lord was setting up a great confrontation, the victorious outcome of which had already been determined; yet one in which Moses and the Israelites had a part to play.

So Moses’ task was at once difficult and, perhaps, not-so-difficult. Not-so-difficult, because Moses was given advance knowledge – He knew what the glorious end would be. Difficult, because he had to see this drama play out “step-by-step”. He might have had questions: “Will God really do what He has said He would do? Have I heard Him correctly? I mean, only a few weeks ago I was herding sheep in Midian! And now...?” From the Burning Bush until he looked over the Promised Land from Mount Nebo, Moses’ faith was challenged.

As is ours. Like Moses, we’ve been given advance knowledge (1 Thessalonians 4:13-18; 2 Thessalonians 2:1-12; The Book of Revelation). We may not know every detail, but we know that in the end, Jesus prevails, and we who follow Him will likewise prevail. Our end will be glorious!

Like Moses, we must see the drama played out “step-by-step”. And, like Moses, we might be tempted to ask the same (or similar) questions. Will God do as He has said He would? He will. Do we believe Him?

As God helps us, we believe Him. He delivers with a mighty hand, so we obey. We believe in the God of the Resurrection, so we, disregarding what may happen to our body listen to Him and follow. Believing in the God who Reigns over all, we speak the word of the Lord – even to Pharaoh, obeying God rather than men.

As we do this, we participate in the growth, influence and power of the great, eternal Kingdom Christ set up long ago, obtaining joy here and for all time. What a privilege we have!

Believe in His promises. And, believing, obey! You won’t regret it.
