## WORDS OF ENCOURAGEMENT

### A WEE LITTLE MAN

“Zacchaeus, make haste and come down, for today I must stay at your house.”

– Luke 19:5b

Zacchaeus was a man held in dishonor. He was a sinner. And, worse, he was on *their* side – on the side of the Romans. A tax collector. A traitor to Israel.

But he wanted to see Jesus. He *had* to see Jesus. However, because of the crowd – everybody wanted to see Him! – he couldn't. Putting aside his dignity as a wealthy man and an official representative of Rome, he found a sycamore tree and scurried up to see Him. And he did.

But Zacchaeus was also seen by the Master, who said to him the words of grace we have already read. The Master – sent to the lost sheep of Israel – reached out to one of those lost sheep. And not only was Zacchaeus lost, but he was also beyond redemption, according to “respectable folk”. So they grumbled. Why would Jesus give positive attention to a Tax Collector?!

Good thing we've outgrown such childish behavior in our day – right? It's a good thing that we would *never* shun a penitent sinner “from the wrong side of the tracks” – right?

Zacchaeus, as we recall, pledged to make right (four times over!) any wrong he might have done in the conduct of his business. He gave half of his goods to the poor. And Jesus, again showing grace to the lowly Zacchaeus, said, “Today salvation has come to this house, for he is also a son of Abraham; for the Son of Man has come to seek and save that which was lost.” (Luke 19:9-10)

What is God telling us here? Is it not that we need to care about the least of these? About *those people*? You know, the ones who aren't “respectable” – like us? The ones who don't run in *our* circles? The ones who, even though they “(seek) to see Jesus” – have a different, perhaps ugly and dirty, past?

Yet *those people* – those *sinners* – are willing to climb a tree, just to get a glimpse of the Master! They are willing to give their all, just to see Him! They are willing to lay aside their dignity and their former life – just to know Him! And they will know Him. Jesus came “to seek and save that which was lost.” Have we? Even if the seeking makes us uncomfortable?

If we are called to “preach the gospel to every creature” (Mark 16:15); if we are called to “...make disciples of all the nations ...” (Matthew 28:19); then we must be willing go anywhere and share Christ with anybody. And we must remember that “All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus.” (Romans 3:23-24). If “all have sinned” then you and I have sinned. If all are “justified freely by His grace” then you and I are justified freely by His grace. Each of us, along with Zacchaeus, live by the grace and mercy of God and therefore have no reason to boast about ourselves. Let's believe that! And share the message!
