WORDS OF ENCOURAGEMENT

“NO GREATER LOVE”

“Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends.” (John 15:13) Twenty-five years ago, this kind of sacrificial love was strongly evident among the passengers and crew of United Airlines Flight 93.

Among the four planes hijacked as part of a coordinated assault on the United States, three reached their intended targets in New York and Washington, D.C. The fourth, Flight 93, departed Newark bound for San Francisco, but soon after, passengers and crew learned through phone calls what had befallen the other aircraft. They faced an agonizing choice. Would they submit to the terrorists, hoping for an unlikely deliverance? Or would they take action against their murderous captors? Many resolved to act.

Father of two Todd Beamer famously recited the Lord’s Prayer with a telephone operator before uttering the even more battle cry, “Let’s roll.” Alongside him were men like Thomas Burnett Jr., Jeremy Glick, Mark Bingham, and others who had families waiting at home. After voting, they then charged the cockpit, attempting to regain control of the aircraft. The airplane crashed in a field near Shanksville, Pennsylvania, likely saving either the United States Capitol or the White House.

These men and women, in an instant, chose to lay down their lives not only for the strangers sitting beside them in the cabin, but for untold numbers of people on the ground who would otherwise have perished. They did not know the names of those they might save. They had no guarantee of success. Yet they acted anyway,

motivated by a fierce love for life; for country; for one another.

The passengers of Flight 93 were not professional soldiers or first responders trained for crisis. They were ordinary travelers with ordinary lives who became friends because of extraordinary circumstances. Transformed in the crucible of mortal danger, strangers became brothers and sisters bound by shared resolve. Choosing to risk everything, they illustrated in their deaths the principle that love prioritizes the well-being of others even above one’s own survival.

Their sacrifice stands in stark contrast to the ideology that sought to destroy. Where Islamic terrorism glorifies death in the advance of a false god, these passengers offered their lives for the preservation of others – people they did not know. Their actions affirm that the highest form of love is not sentimental feeling but costly action – the deliberate choice to protect others, no matter the cost.

The National Memorial in Shanksville honors those who “fought the first battle of the war against terrorism.” Their story reminds us that courage and selflessness are not reserved for the extraordinary; courage and selflessness can arise in ordinary people when the moment demands it. In laying down their lives, the passengers of Flight 93 fulfilled, in a modern and tragic setting, the ancient truth spoken by Jesus: there is no greater love than this.

Their legacy endures as a testament to the human capacity for sacrificial love in the face of murderous evil.
